All players and parents will refrain from posting or sending inappropriate, derogatory, sexually explicit, or any form of negative comments, photos, texts, etc. to any electronic entity. This includes, but is not limited to: Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube, personal email accounts, personal web pages, personal or private chat rooms, personal texting/cell phone accounts, etc.

Sending any form of inappropriate photos, negative comments, profanity etc. will **NOT** be tolerated regardless of intention.

Any use of cameras in the locker room (including cell phone cameras) is strictly forbidden and a USA Hockey violation.

If any player, coach **or parent** violates this policy, disciplinary action will be enforced and may include dismissal from the team.

As team members, coaches and parents, you are choosing to represent Queen City Royals Hockey, and are expected to demonstrate the highest levels of behavior **in and out of season, in and out of uniform, in and out of the rink, and online and offline.**
